

Act-It-Out Animal Adventure

Two or more players. Age range: 4-10

Items needed: paper, scissors and a pencil or pen

Game Variations:

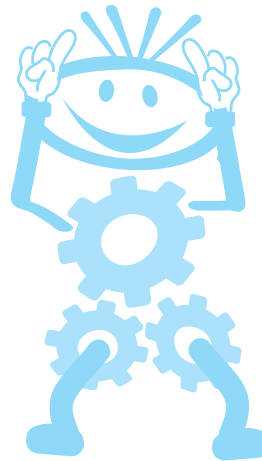
- Play as a team and see how many animals in a row you can guess without getting one wrong.
- Make the game harder by creating more cards. This way, you can save the cards and play again. Make sure to shuffle the cards each time.
- Play the game using types of sports (ex.) soccer, baseball, football, volleyball, basketball, hockey, cheerleading, tennis, etc.

Before You Start:

1. Cut a piece of paper into playing card size pieces.
2. Write a type of animal, such as elephant, kangaroo, monkey, chicken, flamingo, lion, frog, alligator, eagle, snake, rabbit, and turtle, on each piece.
3. Shuffle the cards.

To Play:

1. Player 1 chooses a card. He or she must act out the animal on the card without making any sounds, for 30 seconds.
2. Player 2 tries to guess the animal after the time is up.
3. If Player 2 guesses correctly, he or she gets one point.
4. Switch roles to let the other player act out an animal.
5. The first player to get 5 points wins.
